POSITION TITLE: Unpaid Course & Pattern Design Intern

DEPARTMENT: Winton Woods Riding Center

REPORTS TO: WWRC Staff & Volunteer Services

JOB DESCRIPTION: This internship will revolve around completion of a Course and/or Pattern Design Project, and can be customizable to the interests and background of the potential intern. An example of a suitable project would be: evaluation of current WWRC jump arena jump standards, poles & accessories, refurbishing/repainting of this equipment, designing 24-48 courses making use of this equipment to be used in lesson program and/or Open Horse Show Series. Similar assessment, refurbish and course design projects could be chosen with our outdoor Hilly Terrain Trail Course, and/or our Open Field Hunter/Jumper Course (multi-acre area with cross-country style jumps). Interns could also work to assemble a collection of Horsemanship or Speed & Accuracy Patterns to be used as tools for lesson instruction at varying skill levels. Once being selected for an internship in Course & Pattern Design, interns would need to make a proposal of their project goal to WWRC management. Management will work with intern to develop a project outline, and intern will proceed to accomplish their project within the designated timeframe. Interns will receive hands-on experience in designing and seeing fulfilled a variety of courses to accommodate various skill levels and disciplines.

SKILLS DESIRED: Candidates for this internship will have a prior skill base in styles of riding and course execution.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: While performing duties for this position, the intern might need to stand, walk and uses their hands to hold and control tools. Intern may lift or exert force on items with varying weights.

EQUIPMENT OPERATED: Potentially hand tools such as hammer, hand saw, screwdriver, etc.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Normal working conditions, but with regular exposure to noise, dust, heat, cold, rain, snow and other inclement weather conditions.
