GREAT PARKS RANGERS INVITE CHILDREN TO SAFETY TOWN

Four-wheeled go karts will swerve between obstacles as drivers learn about safety on the road, in the Great Parks Rangers annual Safety Town event from 6-8 p.m. on Wednesday, June 3, at Winton Woods Harbor.

Safety Town is an opportunity for children to meet and interact with Great Parks Rangers, who serve as the law enforcement arm of Great Parks. As the highlight of the event, Rangers set up an obstacle course with cones, traffic signs and even plastic animal replicas to teach young people safety tips for the road. Each participant walks away with a fun swag bag.
