

Scholarship Information

Application Procedures for Individuals:

- Residents of Hamilton County will be given priority. If funds are available, out-of-county individuals will be considered for an award for up to 50% of the cost of the programs.
- Maximum award for Hamilton County residents is 75% of the program cost, not to exceed \$300.00. Out of county residents maximum award is \$200.00.
- Applicants must register for the program first and notify the Great Parks of Hamilton County on the registration that a scholarship application is being submitted along with the registration and pay 25% down on the cost of the program.
- Space in the program is not held until the down payment of 25% has been made. Registration for a place in the program/camp is confirmed only after Great Parks of Hamilton County receives the portion of the registration fees for which the recipient is responsible.
- Print an 'Individual Scholarship Application' and submit it with requested documentation.
- Applications must be received at a minimum of four weeks prior to the start of the program.
- Those awarded scholarships will be responsible to pay the remaining amount and to provide other necessities of the program/camp, for example, lunch, proper clothing, footwear, etc.
- The information provided by individuals and families on these forms will be treated confidentially and will be used only to determine and verify eligibility for scholarship assistance. Scholarships are limited.
- No other scholarship awarded funds may be used to pay for any of the program fees.
- All applicants will be notified concerning the status of their application.

Application Procedures for Groups:

- Groups located within Hamilton County will be given priority. If funds are available, out-of-county groups will be considered for an award for up to 50% of the cost of the programs.
- Maximum award for Hamilton County groups is 75% of the program cost, not to exceed \$300.00. Out of county groups, maximum award is \$200.00.
- Applicants must register for the program first and notify the Great Parks of Hamilton County on the registration that a scholarship application is being submitted along with the registration and pay 25% down on the cost of the program.
